WAIVER OF SUBROGATION REQUIRED
WHERE NOTED BELOW AS WOSR**

CUSTOMER REPS, INSPECTION COMPANIES, LOSS CONTROL: WOSR**

- (1) Comprehensive or Commercial General Liability (minimum \$1,000,000 CSL) naming Chevron Beaumont Terminal as an additional insured,
(2) Comprehensive Automobile Liability (minimum \$500,000 CSL) for all vehicles entering the terminal ("any auto" needs to be marked on certificate), and
(3) evidence of current workers' compensation coverage, (U.S. Longshoremens & Harbor Workers coverage when applicable) or a letter on company letterhead stating the reason that workers' compensation coverage is not required

MARINE CARRIERS (BARGE COMPANIES):

- (1) evidence of insurance at least complying with the requirements of the Oil Pollution Act of 1990 (OPA 90). If OPA 90 does not apply, Unocal will require a minimum of \$5,000,000 Protection & Indemnity coverage.

SHIPS' AGENTS: WOSR**

- (1) Comprehensive or Commercial General Liability (minimum \$1,000,000 CSL) naming Chevron Beaumont Terminal as an additional insured,
(2) Comprehensive Automobile Liability (minimum \$500,000 CSL) for all vehicles entering the terminal("any auto" needs to be marked on certificate), and
(3) evidence of current workers' compensation coverage, showing U.S. Longshoremens & Harbor Workers coverage (if applicable) or a letter on company letterhead stating the reason that workers' compensation coverage is not required

VENDORS: WOSR**

- (1) Comprehensive or Commercial General Liability (minimum \$1,000,000 CSL)
(2) Comprehensive Automobile Liability (minimum \$500,000 CSL) for all vehicles entering the terminal ("any auto" needs to be marked on certificate), and Evidence of current workers' compensation coverage or a letter on company letterhead stating the reason that workers' compensation coverage is not required.
